PRAT- SUBSISTENCE MANNING PEG

MDEP TITLE & DESCRIPTION: PRAT – SUBSISTENCE PART. This program provides funds for procurement of unprepared rations, prepared rations, and operational rations for ARNG soldiers conducting annual training (AT) periods. Statutory training is fifteen days. Generally includes additional days in excess of 15 days per individual for Combat Training Center Events, and deployments for training after AT cycles i.e. advance/rear detachments, pre-camp/site recon, admin/log and shortfalls during AT for peacetime training support.

- *Each Subsistence-In-Kind soldier by statutory entitlement is required to be provided a meal for each eight (8) hour duty period. Army Doctrine is three quality meals per day with a minimum of one hot meal. Meals may be in combination of group served meals or individual meals. Basis of the appropriation is predicated on End Strength of the ARNG.*
- **DOES:** Provides funds to respective ARNG State for SIK personnel conducting annual training (AT) on In-State Operated Installations, on installations other than DA Operated Facilities (where the respective State is the Bill Payer) and Open Allotment/Central reimbursement to DA for ARNG Units conducting annual training on DA operated installations.
- **DOES NOT:** Provide funds for Inactive Duty Training periods (IDT).
